

General Information

The King Riverside Conservation Area consists of approximately 173 acres of woodland in the southeast corner of Tolland. A conservation easement for development rights of the parcel was purchased from the King family in 2007 with assistance from the State of Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection. The property is located off Route 195 on Dimock Road, and allows public access along the Willimantic River.

Existing trails on the 30-acre public access area parallel the river and are clearly marked. The property contains wetlands, farmland and forest. Diverse river habitat, small brooks, floodplain forest, forested swamp, upland oak forest, mixed conifer and oak forest, ledge outcrops, open field, scrub shrub upland, marsh and wet meadow can be found on the property, providing habitat for an enormous variety of wildlife.

Stewardship

The maintenance of our open space parcels is everyone's responsibility. The town has designated that the Conservation Commission develop a stewardship plan for each parcel. Once the plans are approved, the Tolland Conservation Corps provides volunteers to work on the property. The trails, bridges, and parking areas are maintained by a dedicated group of Tolland residents who make up the Conservation Corps.
