

General Information

The Stoppleworth Conservation Area consists of 55 acres of undeveloped woodland, unique geological features, and two brooks that eventually drain to Crystal Lake. A marked trail includes the orange loop, and a white trail at the south edge of the property connects to the Campbell's Peaceful Valley Conservation Area with its own trail system. Stewardship of the property is provided by the Tolland Conservation Corps.

Wildlife Information

A wide variety of wildlife consisting of animals, birds and reptiles can be found on the property. Deer, fox, coyote and the occasional fisher cat have all been spotted along with the usual mix of smaller animals such as squirrels and chipmunks. Birds are plentiful, including forest songbirds, hawks, and owls. The wetlands offer great habitat for many species of reptiles including salamander, turtles and snakes. Sightings of wildlife will vary with the seasons and weather conditions. Best wildlife viewing is generally at dawn and dusk.

Stewardship

The maintenance of our open space parcels is everyone's responsibility. The town has designated that the Conservation Commission develop a stewardship plan for each parcel. Once the plans are approved, the Tolland Conservation Corps provides volunteers to work on the property. The trails, bridges, and parking areas are maintained by a dedicated group of Tolland residents who make up the Conservation Corps. Conservation Areas have been purchased with Town of Tolland open space referendum funds and grants from the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection.



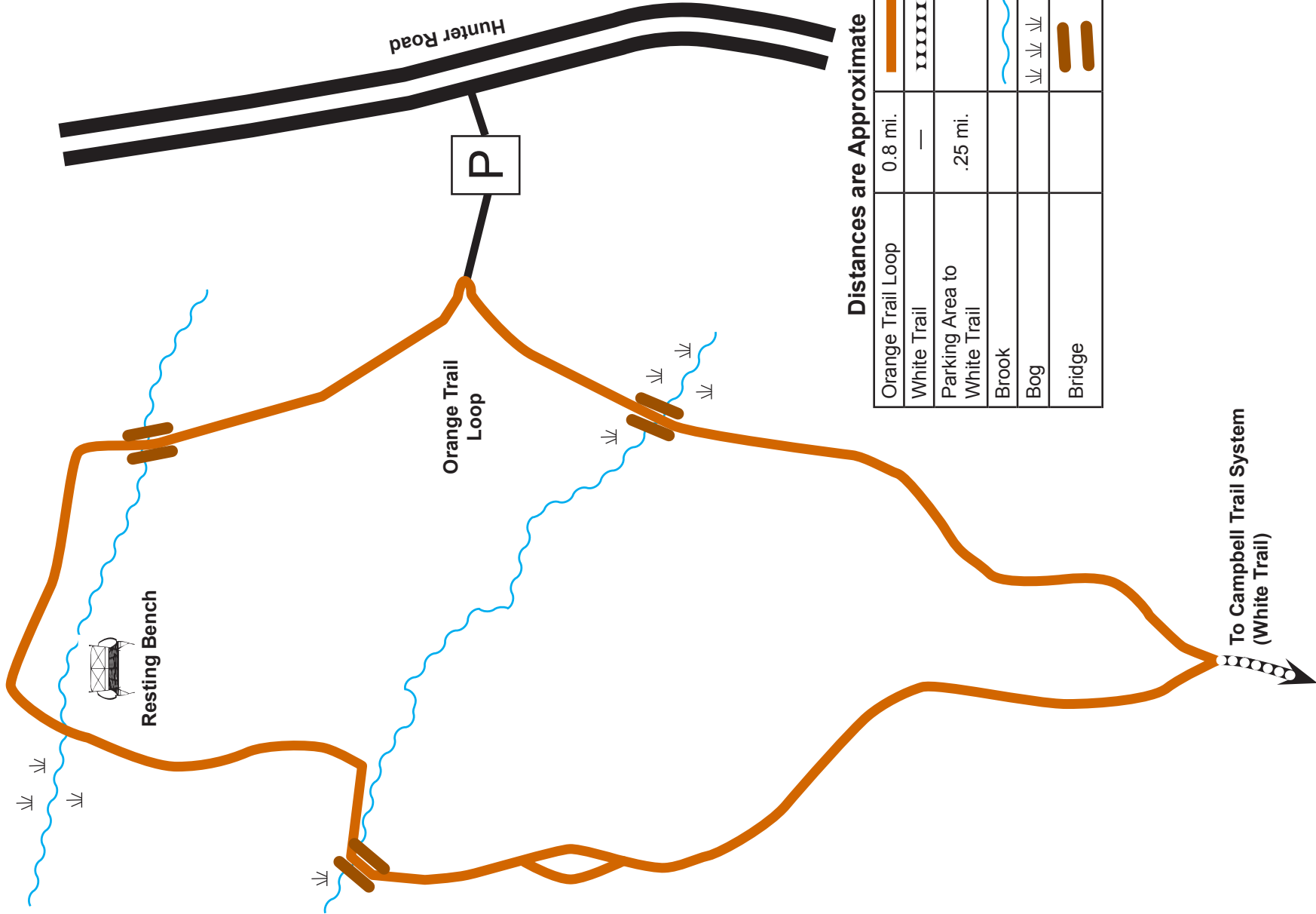
